The tax bills for 2024 were mailed on January 26. This is the third year of the three-year roll, 2022-2023-2024. We'd like to take this opportunity to remind you that the first payment for 2024 must be made no later than March 3, 2024, and the other two payments on June 6 and September 9, 2024. MOOVING ON WATERWAYS



Due to the wide variations in temperature over the last few years, many rivers and streams will not freeze properly and can be risky during the winter. Before venturing onto a river, it's essential to take the necessary precautions.

Observe the color of the ice: blue, transparent ice is usually more resistant. White, opaque ice contains a high proportion of air, so its resistance depends on its density. Grey ice usually contains a portion of water, due to thawing for

example, and is considered dangerous. No type of ice is 100% safe.

We also recommend that you never venture onto a waterway alone.

WATER PATROL AND VIGNETTES

Once again this year, the Municipality will have a water patrol. We would like to remind you that the aim of the water patrol is to ensure compliance with the boating code and federal restrictions, and to raise awareness of the need for safety and respect among users and boaters on Lake Manitou.

ORGANIC MATERIALS

LOOSE OR IN A PAPER BAG

FOOD RESIDUES

- Food (cooked, raw, spoiled or frozen)
- Pet food
- Fruit and vegetables, pasta, breads and cereals, flour and sugar
- Non-liquid dairy products
- Sweets and confectionary
- Coffee (beans, grounds and filters), tea bags and herbal teas
- Fish, meat, bones
- Crab and lobster shells, eggshells and walnut shells

SOILED PAPERS AND CARDBOARD

- Paper plates or glasses, cardboard soiled with food (pizza)
- Soiled paper towels, tissues and napkins
- Small bamboo items (remove plastic and metal parts)

GREEN WASTE

- Dead leaves and garden residues: flowers, plants, conifer needles, hedge trimmings and weeds (except exotic and invasive plants)
- Grass, sawdust, bark, wood chips and houseplants

OTHER MATERIALS

- Cold ashes, after 4 weeks, tobacco and cigarette paper
- Hair, pet hair, litter for small animals (cats, rabbits, hamsters)

NO PLASTIC BAGS IN MY BIN, EVEN IF THEY ARE COMPOSTABLE!

WASTE

Waste is end-of use objects that cannot be put in the brown or green bin, or at the ecocenter, or at entrance counters

ACCEPTED

- Diapers
- Broken toys
- Brushes and mirrors
- Broken and plain dishes
- Dishwashing gloves and sponges
- Plastic straw

- Plastic toothbrushes
- Rigid plastic bags (chip bags, etc.)
- Any compostable and biodegradable plastic
- Etc.

HOW TO PLACE YOUR BINS FOR COLLECTION

Wheels and handles facing home

Bins placed side by side and 60cm (2 ft) apart

- Newspapers, flyers and magazines
- Sheets of paper and envelopes
- Shredded paper (in a clear, knotted bag)
- Unsoiled brown paper
- Cardboard boxes and packaging (unpack boxes)
- Books and books (without cover or binding)
- Milk, cream and juice cartons (without straw)

PLASTICS

- All numbered containers and covers:

All plastic bags, packaging and pellets that stretch easily (put them in a transparent, knotted bag)

METAL

- Tin can
- Cans
- Plates and aluminium foil
- Hangers (to be bundled)

GLASS

All glass bottles and containers, in all colors

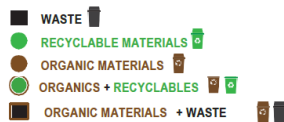

As announced in our January 2024 newsletter, the Town of Sainte-Agathe-des-Monts has adopted draft by-law 2024-M-371 concerning the pricing of municipal services, including recreation services. This new by-law now includes the citizens of Ivry-sur-le-Lac, part of the agglomeration of Sainte-Agathe-des-Monts.

By purchasing the Agglomération - Sainte-Agathe-des-Monts citizen card, you will benefit from the same rates as Sainte-Agathe-des-Monts residents.

The rate is valid for all activities offered at the Centre sportif Damien-Héty, such as swimming lessons, public swim, field hockey, figure skating lessons and public skating. The card also includes free access to the Gaston-Miron library, the Le Bel Âge community hall and the Pierre-Fournelle ball field.

Ivry-Sur-Le-Lac residents will also enjoy free access to the three outdoor pickleball courts (Parc Lionel-Groulx, Parc du Mont-Catherine and Stationnement de la Plage Major), as well as indoor pickleball at Fleur-des-Neiges school.

LUCIA'S MULTIMEDIA POESY

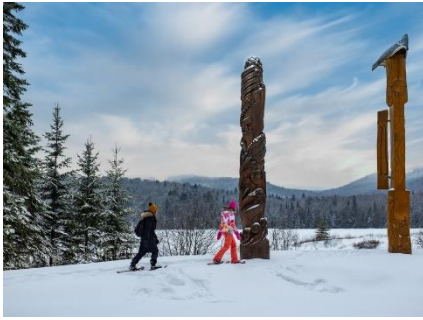
Come and enjoy a unique poetic experience at Espace public de Mont-Tremblant, where Lucia, an interactive multimedia work, will be installed.

The work tells the story of the tragic fate of Lucia, a ballerina from Ravenna, Italy, whose hope is reborn thanks to Giorgio, the lamplighter. With the help of the villagers, he builds a giant music box at the top of which stands the dancer. With each turn of the crank operated by the hands of passers-by, the 2.4 m-high sculpture springs to life, lighting up

the streetlamps.

Enhanced by original classical music performed by the Orchestre symphonique de Montréal, the installation presents its story in the form of an animated film, which is revealed on the music box as the audience interacts with it.

Young people aged 17 and under accompanied by an adult are admitted free of charge to the national parks. They do, however, require an access permit.
