FOLLOW-UP TO DISCUSSIONS AT THE NOVEMBER 2025 CAUCUS

Hello Ivry citizens,

Your council held its first caucus meeting on November 10, and as promised during the election campaign, the monthly newsletter will now include a summary of the topics discussed at the meeting, as well as an overview of the resolutions that will be proposed at the next regular council meeting.

This will allow citizens to prepare for the question period at the beginning of the council meeting regarding any item on the agenda.

Any citizen wishing to meet with me may do so on the third Monday of each month. Meetings will be held at City Hall starting at 4:00 p.m. Please make an appointment by contacting Ms. Marie-France Matteau at 819-321-2332, ext. 3701.

1. Post-election discussions :

The Council members reviewed the election platform presented to citizens during the campaign and focused on the following actions to be taken:

Point 2.2 of the Platform :

Undertake a scientific study to assess the effects of wake surfing on the shoreline and lake bottom in several stages:

Step 1: Preliminary Data Collection and Literature Review

The initial phase focuses on gathering all relevant existing information in order to define the scope and refine the research questions.

- Compilation of internal data
- Collection of usage data
- Literature review

Step 2: Development of the Request for Proposals

The Request for Proposals will formally solicit proposals from qualified environmental consulting firms or university research teams.

Step 3: Proposal evaluation criteria

Proposals received will be evaluated by an internal committee (the mayor, council members, a few community representatives, and an independent expert/engineer with no conflict of interest).

Step 4: Nature and scope of the mandate (Scope of Work)

The mandate must be objective and quantifiable, directly addressing the concerns and allegations of the public.

Step 5: Final report and recommendations

The consulting firm will analyze the data and prepare the final report.

Point 2.13 of the Platform:

Minimizing light pollution:

The council will undertake a review of its lighting regulations to implement measures to minimize light pollution. This will include allocating funds in the next budget to replace standard light bulbs on our roads with LED bulbs.

Points 3.1 and 3.2 of our Platform:

3.1 Create and distribute a monthly report of topics discussed at Caucus meetings and a summary of proposed regulations at Council meetings;

3.2 Continue to make Council meetings accessible by teleconference and secure, so that meetings are as accessible as possible;

Points 4.3, 4.4, and 4.5 of our Platform:

4.3 Review and simplify our outdated municipal regulations.

4.4 Revise Ivry's bylaws to facilitate the permit application process.

4.5 Review outdated and unnecessarily burdensome regulations.

The council will create a working committee comprising council and CCU members, municipal staff, community representatives, and professional support to undertake a comprehensive review of the regulations.

At the same time, the council will ask the director general to redouble efforts to find a permanent urban planner.

Items discussed on the caucus agenda:

Several requests for financial assistance will be granted, such as:

- Bouffe Laurentienne
- Palliaccio
- Operation Red Nose

A mandate will be granted to obtain a hydrogeomorphological diagnosis concerning the heavy water flow on Lacasse Road, which is causing damage to municipal infrastructure and Lake Manitou. The mandate will be awarded to Flovio and will commence in spring 2026. The costs of this mandate will be covered by the surplus.

Councilor Maxime Arcand will be appointed as deputy mayor for a one-year term and representative to the Laurentides Regional County Municipality, the Régie incendie des Monts (RIDM) fire department, and the Régie intermunicipale des trois lacs (RITL) intermunicipal agency.

NEXT COUNCIL MEETING

The next council meeting will be held on Monday, **December 15, 2025**, starting at 6 p.m. The mayor and council members will welcome you at City Hall, located at 601 Chemin de la Gare. EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

The Municipality has drawn up an emergency measures plan in line with the laws and regulations currently in force in the field of civil protection in Quebec. It takes into account the various approaches proposed by the Ministère de la Sécurité publique (MSP), as well as the current realities and challenges facing municipalities. The plan is intended as a working tool before, during and after the occurrence of disasters or emergency measures.

All players, at all levels of society, are called upon to participate in risk and disaster management. This implies a sharing of responsibilities that requires the contribution of all players in the community.

The MSP describes the 4 dimensions of civil protection as prevention, preparedness, response and recovery.

Action plans are drawn up according to the type of disaster envisaged.

Various means that the municipality can use to communicate with its citizens in the event of a disaster or emergency measure: Site web de la municipalité

- Using the Voilà! platform where citizens must be registered
- Telmatik where citizens must be registered
- Recorded telephone message from the municipality
- Social networks: Facebook, etc
- Newsletter
- Press release
- Québec en alerte

The new premises at City Hall were designed to house the Emergency Measures Coordination Centre (Centre de coordination des mesures d'urgence) (CCMU). Having an external system to ensure a sufficient supply of electricity to be functional and offer citizens a safe place in the event of a disaster.

VULNERABLE PERSONS REGISTER

The Ministère de la Sécurité publique and the Direction de la sécurité civile et de la sécurité d'incendie are promoting the importance of keeping a municipal register of vulnerable residents. In the event of a civil protection incident, some people - the elderly or disabled, for example, who are losing their physical or mental autonomy - may require special assistance from local responders. The purpose of the registry is to identify the particularities that need to be taken into account during an intervention. Responders are then better equipped to offer an adapted and efficient service during a disaster.

The municipality of Ivry-sur-le-Lac has such a register. It is therefore essential to obtain this information from our citizens. There are two ways to register yourself or a loved one:

This kind of action can make a difference and save lives!

BINS AND SNOW REMOVAL



It's **ESSENTIAL** to place your bin **IN** your driveway, 1 m from the street. This has a host of advantages:

- Your bin won't interfere with snow clearing, especially when streets get narrower and narrower due to snow accumulation.
 - It won't be destroyed by the plow, so you won't have to order a new one.
 - You won't have to pick up the contents of the bin, which will be scattered on the ground if the plow knocks it over;
 - You'll make our operators' work easier, and they'll be able to clear the snow faster and more efficiently - all our citizens will benefit!
 - What's more, you'll save a few steps since you don't have to put your bin on the street, but **IN YOUR ENTRANCE**, 1 metre from the pavement!
- Returning your bin at the end of collection will also save you a lot of inconvenience. Damaged bins are replaced at the owner's expense.


