COUNCIL MEETING

The next Council meeting will be held exceptionally on Tuesday, May 20, 2025, starting at 6 p.m. The Mayor and Council members will welcome you at the Town Hall offices, 601 chemin de la Gare. You may also attend by videoconference.

ABOUT YOU – PROPERTY VALUE - INFORMATION

Every 3 years, the MRC des Laurentides, the municipal body responsible for property assessment, is responsible for drawing up the property assessment roll in compliance with the Act respecting municipal taxation (LFM), section 14.

The 2025 roll represents an average increase of 68.49%.

The reference date for the real value of properties is July 1, 2023, based on the real estate market. Furthermore, a municipality cannot refuse to deposit the assessment roll.

Each property represents a different situation, so it is important to contact the MRC des Laurentides assessment department at 819 425-5555 ext. 1023 or by e-mail at evaluation@mrclaurentides.qc.ca

All property owners have the right to file a request for review in accordance with sections 124 et seq. of the Act respecting municipal taxation (LFM).

Before submitting a request, it is preferable to contact the MRC des Laurentides assessment department to understand the reasons for changes in values.

To be admissible, the request must :

- - Be submitted before May 1, 2025;
- - Be accompanied by the amount specified in by-law 416-2024;
- - Be made on the prescribed form;
- - be deposited at Ivry-sur-le-Lac town hall or sent by mail to the MRC des Laurentides.

Consolidating lots belonging to the same owner can have a significant impact on property value. A number of conditions must be met for a grouping.

According to section 34 of the Act respecting municipal taxation (LFM), lot consolidation is only possible under the following conditions:

- The properties are contiguous, or would be if they weren't separated by a waterway, road or public utility network;
- If the buildings are used, they are used for the same predominant purpose; and
- The properties can normally only be disposed of in the short term as a whole, and not in parts, taking into account the most probable use to which they can be put.

WATERCRAFT – LANDING – VIGNETTES - REMINDER



The official opening of the carwash and landing stage has yet to be determined. Keep an eye on our website, which will inform you as soon as the date is set.

Washing boats, trailers, nautical equipment and material is essential and **MANDATORY** for all types of craft.

Prevention is the best option. Considering that scientific studies have shown that invasive exotic species can cause considerable damage, particularly to flora, fauna, water quality, public health and the property value of waterfront properties, we have taken steps to ensure that water quality is maintained.

A NEW FEATURE FOR VIGNETTES

The administrative team is pleased to announce that the software for obtaining your vignette is now online. You will now be able to obtain your vignette for both motorized and non-motorized boats in just one click! Payment can also be made online via a secure site.

Make sure your file is complete to obtain your vignette, as access to the lake may be denied if it is not.

HOW TO GET YOUR VIGNETTE

SCHEDULE

From opening* to July 1, 2025 7 days from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

July 2 to August 31, 2025 5 days/week, Wednesday to Sunday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

September 1 to October 17, 2025 7 days from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

*The opening will take place no later than the weekend of May 23-25, 2025. Weather permitting, the opening will be brought forward, and we will keep you informed.

Hours may vary, without notice, depending on the availability of human resources assigned to the landing and carwash stations, and on traffic during the season.

VIGNETTES: It is essential that you obtain a vignette for any type of boat.

ROAD WORKS - REMINDER

Clean-up work has begun. We'll be installing stop signs on chemin Fyon and speed bumps on certain paths. The safety of our team is paramount, so please be vigilant!

GROUND MAINTENANCE

It's important to maintain your roadside property (cedar hedges, dead trees, etc.) for the safety of road users and to ensure that visibility is not impaired at any time.

CULVERT CLEANING - DRIVEWAY



We'd like to remind you that it's vital to keep your culverts clean to ensure that rainwater runs off properly. After the cold season, a lot of gravel can end up in the ditch, sometimes clogging your culvert. It's your responsibility to make sure there's no accumulation of gravel or stones that could prevent proper drainage.

CARPORTS - REMINDER

As spring gradually sets in, it's time to think about putting away your carport. The presence of a temporary carport in all setbacks and parking areas is authorized from October 1 of one year to May 1 of the following year under by-law no. 2013-060, and sections 206 and 368, so it's important to plan for its removal before the end of the permitted period.

However, it is possible to install a temporary shelter between May 1 and October 1 of the same year under certain conditions, including if it is installed in the rear lateral setbacks, and is not visible from a public or private road.

GREEN WASTE - REMINDER

GREEN WASTE – TOO VALUABLE TO PUT IN THE GARBAGE

Spring weather means outdoor chores. Green waste, such as branches less than 4 cm in diameter, dead leaves, flowers, plants, softwood needles, bark and wood chips, is welcome in the brown bin. These residues will be composted and used to nourish the earth!

Other options for disposing of your green waste in an environmentally-friendly way;

- Leave grass clippings on the ground after mowing. The nitrogen-rich clippings will be quickly reabsorbed by the soil, enriching the lawn.
- In autumn, mow dead leaves to the ground and leave the shredded leaves on the lawn, or lay them out as mulch in flowerbeds or the garden.
- Store a quantity of dead leaves in a large bag and use them at any time of the year in your brown bin, alternating with food waste. In the summer, leaves help reduce odours from the brown bin during hot weather.

When green waste is deposited in your black bin, it ends up in landfill sites and produces methane, a gas that is a nuisance in terms of odor and contributes to the greenhouse effect. In fact, methane is 21 times more harmful than the carbon dioxide in our cars. The importance of changing our habits is paramount!

THE DANDELION CHALLENGE



Join the common effort to protect pollinating insects, especially bees, whose numbers are in serious decline. You're invited to postpone the first mowing of your lawn and let the dandelions complete their flowering so that insects can feed on them. The dandelion flower is one of the first to bloom in spring, so let's put our collective energies elsewhere than on lawn mowing.

RESIDENTIAL POOLS ON THE TERRITORY

Residential swimming pools, whether in-ground, above-ground, semi-in-ground or even inflatable, present significant drowning risks for young children when they are away from adult supervision and installations are not adequately secured. To ensure everyone's safety, by September 30, 2025, owners of residential pools will have to comply with the Règlement sur la sécurité des piscines résidentielles .

All other residential pools must already comply with this by-law. Among the measures to be implemented, note that any access to a pool 60 cm or more deep must be fenced, even if access to the yard is already controlled by a fence.

The provincial by-law applies to all pools, regardless of when they were installed, and essentially aims to control access to residential pools through simple measures, such as the installation of an enclosure equipped with a security gate. Previously exempt owners have until September 30, 2025 to bring their installations up to standard.

The Municipality is responsible for enforcing the provincial Residential Swimming Pool Safety By-law on its territory.

In the event that work is required to bring the installation into compliance, a permit application must be submitted to the urban planning department BEFORE the work begins. An analysis is required to ensure that the work submitted complies with the applicable provisions.

Please note that a municipal permit is required for the following types of work:

- building, installing or replacing a swimming pool
- install a diving board;
- build a fence enclosure, platform or deck opening onto a pool.

Violation of the swimming pool by-law may result in penalties.

The Municipality is responsible for enforcing the provincial Residential Swimming Pool Safety By-law on its territory.

FOREST FIRE PREVENTION – SOPFEU



SOPFEU took advantage of Earth Day to launch a major new advertising campaign aimed at raising public awareness of forest fire prevention.

The campaign is designed to remind Quebecers of the right behaviours to avoid the 370 or so human-caused forest fires that occur in the province every year.

Under the theme “Avoid avoidable fires”, the SOPFEU campaign will focus on the three main causes of human-caused fires: cigarette butts (80 fires/year), waste burning (75 fires/year) and campfires (60 fires/year).

The aim of the campaign is to reduce the number of human-caused forest fires, which account for 80% of all fires affecting Quebec forests every year.

With climate change bringing more frequent periods of drought and increased fire risk, SOPFEU believes that prevention and public awareness are more necessary than ever. SOPFEU urges the public to exercise the utmost caution as the forest fire season gets underway.

Managing open fires involves several aspects to ensure safety and minimize environmental impact.


Safety:

- Control: Keep an eye on your fire at all times and have water nearby.
- Safety distance: Maintain a minimum distance of 3 meters around the fire.
- Extinguish: Extinguish the fire completely by dousing it with plenty of water and mixing the embers. A poorly extinguished fire can reignite several hours later, particularly under the effect of wind.
- Limits : The size of the fire should not exceed one metre by one metre, in order to better control it.

Prohibitions:

- It is forbidden to burn garbage, treated or painted wood, grass, dead leaves and other polluting materials.

It is everyone's responsibility to follow safety precautions.





Applications are processed in order of receipt. By proceeding without delay, you can limit the number of surprises.
