VULNERABLE PERSONS REGISTER - REMINDER



VULNERABLE PERSONS REGISTER

The Ministère de la Sécurité publique and the Direction de la Sécurité civile et de la Sécurité incendie are promoting the importance of keeping a municipal register of vulnerable residents. In the event of a civil protection incident, some people - the elderly or disabled, for example, who are losing their physical or mental autonomy - may require special assistance from local responders. The purpose of the registry is to identify the particularities that need to be taken into account during an intervention. Responders are then better equipped to offer an adapted and effective service during a disaster.

The municipality of Ivry-sur-le-Lac has such a register. It is therefore essential to obtain this information from our citizens. There are two ways to register yourself or a loved one:

FIRE SAFETY – PROPER USE OF RECHARGEABLE APPLIANCES

To prevent fire when using rechargeable devices :

CONSEIL DE PRÉVENTION

- Read the manufacturer's instructions carefully and follow them at all times.
- Respect the maximum charging time.
- Use the charger supplied or an approved model.
- Avoid exposing the charger to water, heat or extreme cold.

- Do not modify or tamper with the charger.
- Regularly check the charger for damage.
- Dispose of batteries at a depot or ecocenter. Never put them in the garbage or recycling bin, as they could start a fire if crushed by equipment.
