TEMPORARY WINTER SHELTERS

The shelter must be removed by May 1, 2025, at the latest.

Smoke Alarm Test Day and Fire Prevention Week 2025

Fire prevention starts with simple but essential actions. This fall, two major initiatives offer you the opportunity to take action.

Smoke Alarm Test Day – September 28

For the third year, this Canada-wide fire prevention initiative is raising awareness about the importance of checking smoke alarms

On **September 18**, the Department of Public Safety (DPS) will post a reminder on its social media accounts that the provincial smoke alarm testing day will take place in “10 days.”

On **September 28**, a message will encourage the public to “take action now.”

Fire Prevention Week (FPW) – October 5 to 11

This year, SPI will focus on electrical hazards in the home. Throughout the week, MSP and its partners will be sharing various prevention messages to encourage good fire safety practices in the home.

Electrical appliances and power distribution equipment are the source of fires in 23% of damaged residential buildings, a statistic that reminds us of the importance of being vigilant.

Every day in Quebec, an average of 13 homes are damaged by fire.
